"TO BRING" LIST FOR CAMP

Please note that for Day Camps, campers only need a swimsuit, towel, rain coat, water bottle, and a change of clothes all in a backpack. This is a list of other optional items that you may wish to pack for your child.

General Items

- Water bottle
- Writing paper and pen or pencil
- Flashlight (and extra batteries) (Thursday sleepover)
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Washcloth and towels (one could be a beach towel)
- Small daypack for carrying items
- Bible (see note)

BIBLES: If campers do not have a Bible, one will be provided for use during their time at camp.

Clothing Items

- Long pants/jeans
- Shorts
- Swim suit
- Shirts
- Two pairs of comfortable shoes (one for water activities that may get wet)
- Socks and undergarments
- Sleepwear (Thursday night sleepover)
- Jacket, sweater and/or sweatshirt
- Plastic rain coat or poncho
- Hat

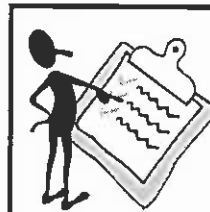
APPROPRIATE ATTIRE: Campers are discouraged from wearing clothing that is too revealing (such as halter tops, short shorts, short skirts, strapless tops, or shirts/tops that reveal a bare midriff) or that displays inappropriate themes.

Bedding

- Pillow and pillow case (for Thursday night sleepover or rest time)
- One fitted/one flat single sheet and an extra blanket **OR** a sleeping bag

Optional Items

- Medications (bring to check-in on the opening day, so please do not pack in your suitcase)
- musical instrument
- Your own personal life jacket (we provide life jackets, but you can bring your own if you have one)
- Reading material
- Stamped envelopes or post cards
- Camera
- Dirty clothes bag



REMEMBER:

- to label your belongings whenever possible
- the camp environment is rough on clothes

What-Not-To-Bring

Please do not bring televisions, portable DVD players, video games, **wireless phones**, candy/snacks, extra money (all refreshments are provided- no drink or snack machines on site), fireworks, radio/tape/CD/MP3 players, pdas, laptops, laser pointers, pagers, heelys/roller shoes, jewelry, pets, alcohol, tobacco products, illegal drugs, pocket knives or any other weapon.

MOBILE PHONES: Campers are asked to leave mobile phones at home during their time at camp. Please see the confirmation letter for ways to communicate with your camper. We will make sure that campers receive any emergency messages.
