

Bethelwoods 2024 Summer Staff Jobs

Leadership Staff - 3 positions (One in charge of each Day Camp, Res Camp, and Camp-in-a-Van)

Description: These staff members are responsible for leading and facilitating the various summer programs Bethelwoods offers. This includes but is not limited to, Day Camp, Residential Camp, and Camp-in-a-Van. Daily responsibilities include communicating with Day Camp parents, supporting and leading Counseling staff and campers, planning and leading night activities, communicating any needs with the Program Director, and assisting with Staff Training. Leadership Staff members may rotate throughout the summer depending on their specific capabilities and the week-to-week needs of Bethelwoods Summer Camp programs. All Leadership Staff members report directly to Full-time Staff (Camp Director, Program Director, and Program Associate). \$325 per week plus room and board; May 24th – August 9th

Camp Counselor - 12+ positions (Age 18+)

Description: Counselors' primary responsibilities include supervising children and youth (K-12th grade) in a cabin setting. This includes but is not limited to staying in cabins overnight with campers, dealing with minor behavioral issues, and participating in all activities and programs unless otherwise specified by the directors. Counselors lead Bible studies, recreation, activities, and worship. They will rotate between resident camp, day camp, and camp-in-a-van programming. They are responsible to their leadership staff and ultimately to the Full-time Staff. \$300 per week plus room and board; May 27th - August 9th

Camp Counselor - 4 positions (Age 17+)

Description: Counselors' primary responsibilities include supervising children and youth (K-12th grade) in a camp setting. This includes but is not limited to dealing with minor behavioral issues, interacting with parents at check-in and check-out, and participating in all activities and programs unless otherwise specified by the directors. Counselors lead Bible studies, recreation, activities, and worship. They will rotate between day camp and camp-in-a-van programming. They are responsible to their leadership staff and ultimately to the Full-time Staff. \$300 per week plus room and board; May 27th - August 9th

Lifeguard - 1-2 positions (certification will be provided by Bethelwoods)

Description: Lifeguards will be responsible for regular pool maintenance and cleaning, including daily safety and cleanliness checks of the pool and bathrooms. Lifeguards serve both campers and hosted groups at camp. When not assigned pool and lifeguard-related duties, this staff member will serve as support staff, performing additional tasks as needed for the summer camp ministry. All lifeguards report directly to Full-time Staff. \$300 per week plus room and board; May 27th - August 9th

Photographer - 1 position (Age 17+)

Description: The Photographer will take and edit videos and photographs of all Summer Camp programs. Additionally, the photographer will assist the Program Staff with social media posts, website updates, and the creation of promotional materials as necessary. This staff member will

support counselors, performing additional tasks (covering blocks, setting up for themed weeks, helping with registration, and more) as needed for the betterment of Bethelwoods Summer Camp ministry. Photographer reports directly to Full-time Staff. \$300 per week plus room and board; May 27th - August 9th

Food Service Staff - 4+ positions (16+)

Description: These individuals report directly to the Food Service Manager. Food Service Staff are responsible for timely preparation and service of meals while maintaining a clean and sanitary environment. These individuals are also tasked with the clean-up of food prep services and dishes. This is an hourly position. May 27th -August 9th

Maintenance Staff - 1-2 positions (16+)

The maintenance staff's primary responsibility are assisting the Facilities and Maintenance Manager with groundskeeping, mowing, weed eating, etc., and other maintenance needs of a busy site. Must have the ability to lift 50 pounds and be open to on-the-job learning. Age 16 and up. This is an hourly position. May 27th - August 9th; Ages 16 & Up
